Internet Safety

Obviously the Internet is a really valuable resource but equally it does present its challenges. In school that usually resolves around keeping the children safe on line. We have Internet Safety lessons in September of every year to ensure that children remember how to use the Internet responsibly.

They are working towards being a SMART learner

- SAFE- No Secrets, Don't share your details
- MEETING- Never meet strangers
- ACCEPTABLE- Take care with attachments, emails etc.
- RELIABLE- Is your source reliable?
- TELL Tell if you are worried about something.

Cyber bullying is always an area we teach. Children have to know what to do if they are receiving unkind messages. Photographs are a new medium we need to consider with the emergence of many new social media sites. Children and young people will be the first generation that will have their life tracked by a series of photographs which will be on the Internet forever. We as a school have a duty of care to ensure that the photographs we release onto the website are respectful of our parents' views and follow data protection regulations. Most of the photographs on the website are of larger, more anonymized groups of pupils.
