This is because a child eating a nut would result in a severe anaphylactic shock which could be life threatening. We have a child joining school next week who has a severe allergy to nuts, eggs and sesame seeds and as a result we would like to do the same for these ingredients. I hope you all understand that these small changes to your child's lunch will have a big impact on these children's health.

Church House staff Car Park

Please remember that parents are not allowed to park in the Church House Car Park at any time. This includes breakfast club and after school clubs. This is for several reasons such as safety; it takes parking places from the staff and may lead to damage to property. Just recently we have noticed that both to a gate and bench have been hit. The benches were placed there because this area is a pedestrian space.

The damage to the gates was done yesterday afternoon, please see pictures attached. These were not inconsiderable investments, the gates cost the school £5,000 and the PTA paid £1,600 for the benches.
